To further support arts in schools, the Mother Lode Art Association *will be choosing a number of pieces from the Youth Arts Show that will be included with the other entries at the Opera Hall during Art Week, April 8th to April 16th.* Judging for these pieces will include all grades and will be done by MLAA judges, April 5th after judging the MLAA show.

After the close of the MLAA Show at the Opera House, YAS artwork will be returned to the library for the last week of the show. Works can be picked up at the library after the close of the Youth Arts Show, **April 26th through the 28th during library hours.**

For Schools & Teachers...

Schools will receive Flyers with instructions for the show via the PONY.

Every effort will be made to contact each school and identify a liason at the school, so that the faculty will be aware of the upcoming show, and show deadlines.

MLAA will require a release form separate from the TCA release form. This must be signed by the teacher that is entering the pieces, and it will be a part of the teacher's packet.

Your school liason will receive a packet of Avery Labels with instructions. Teachers will affix these to the back of the artwork.
